**ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

On July 23, 2002, the Commission issued its Report and Order in this case, effective August 2. On July 29, Missouri-American Water Company filed its motion requesting that the Commission extend the effective date of the Report and Order by 30 days, to September 1, in order to permit Missouri-American to prepare appropriate replacement sheets for the tariff sheet that the Report and Order requires Missouri-American to withdraw. However, despite the need for prompt action, Missouri-American's motion does not state whether or not any of the other parties oppose or object to the requested extension. Therefore, the Commission will require each party to file a pleading stating whether or not it objects to the motion.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That each party hereto, excepting only Missouri-American Water Company, shall by 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 31, 2002, file its pleading stating whether or not it objects to Missouri-American's Motion for Extension of Effective Date.

2. That this order shall become effective on July 31, 2002.
