

Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy (“DE”) witness Mark Hyman expressed concern that as far as the Commission’s request for information on inclining block rates in this case, “[n]o party has provided the requisite information to allow the Commission to make such a consideration.”⁴

To allow the Commission an opportunity to review information prior to the evidentiary hearing, the Commission will direct MAWC to file the following data on residential water customer usage for the period of January 1, 2016, through December 31, 2017:


1. For each month or quarter (depending on the available data) the total number of residential water customers and the number of residential water customers with usage of over 5,000 gallons if billed monthly/15,000 gallons if billed quarterly. A description should be provided for the length of the billing cycle.
2. For each month or quarter (depending on the available data) the total number of residential water customers and the number of residential water customers with usage of over 10,000 gallons if billed monthly/30,000 gallons if billed quarterly. A description should be provided for the length of the billing cycle.
3. For each month or quarter (depending on the available data) the total number of residential water customers and the number of residential water customers with usage of over 20,000 gallons if billed monthly/60,000 gallons if billed quarterly. A description should be provided for the length of the billing cycle.
4. For each month or quarter (depending on the available data) the total number of residential water customers and the number of residential water customers with usage of over 30,000 gallons if billed monthly/90,000 gallons if billed quarterly. A description should be provided for the length of the billing cycle.
