COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"), by and through counsel, and for its *Second Request for Extension of Time*, states as follows:

1. On February 4, 2021, William B. Rilenge ("Complainant") filed a complaint with the Missouri Public Service Commission against Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC").

2. On February 5, 2021, the Commission issued its *Order Giving Notice of Complaint and Directing Answer*. The *Order* directed Staff to file a pleading no later than March 15, 2021, suggesting a date for filing a Staff Report and Recommendation.

3. On March 15, 2021, Staff suggested a filing deadline of April 23, 2021. Also on March 15, 2021, the Commission issued its *Order Directing Filing*, ordering Staff to file a Report and Recommendation no later than April 23, 2021.

4. On April 23, 2021, Staff requested and was granted until May 18, 2021, to file its Report and Recommendation.

5. Staff continues to investigate Mr. Rilenge's complaint but has not received adequate responses to all of its data requests.

6. Staff requests an additional thirty days to seek clarifying information from the Company and complete its investigation. Staff will file its recommendation sooner if possible.

WHEREFORE, Staff prays that the Commission will grant it until June 18, 2021, to complete its investigation and file its report; and such other and further relief as the Commission deems just in these circumstances.
