- 1. On April 22, 2022, Staff filed *Staff's Complaint* concerning the unauthorized provision of water and sewer service by Respondent I-70 Mobile City, Inc., d/b/a I-70 Mobile City Park to the public. These dockets are assigned case numbers WC-2022-0295 and SC-2022-0296.
- 2. Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.110(3) allows the Commission to consolidate pending actions involving related questions of law or fact.¹
- 3. On May 10, 2022, Respondent requested that the Complaint be referred to a neutral third-party mediator for voluntary mediation.
- 4. Staff filed its response to Respondent's Request for Mediation on May 16, 2022.
- 5. There are common questions of law and fact in the above-referenced cases and their consolidation would be administratively expedient and simplify filings.
