- 2 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Welcome everyone to
- 3 Jefferson City, as well as people on the telephone. We're
- 4 here for a prehearing conference in Case No. WC-2006-0082,
- 5 which is actually a consolidation of nine separate
- 6 complaints. The name on the first case is Kathy Orler,
- 7 and there are other complainants as well. The defendant
- 8 in each case is Folsom Ridge, LLC, which is owning and
- 9 controlling the Big Island Homeowners Association. That's
- 10 the way the complaint was filed.
- 11 As indicated, we're here today for a
- 12 prehearing conference, and the way we're going to start
- 13 this out is I'm going to take entries of appearance, just
- 14 so that everyone knows who's here in the room and so
- 15 that's on the record. Some of the parties are represented
- 16 by attorneys. Others are here representing themselves.
- 17 So we'll begin with Folsom Ridge.
- MR. COMLEY: Good afternoon, Judge. Let
- 19 the record reflect the entry of appearance of Mark W.
- 20 Comley, Newman, Comley & Ruth, 601 Monroe Street,
- 21 Suite 301, Jefferson City, Missouri, on behalf of Folsom
- 22 Ridge, LLC.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you, Mr. Comley.
- 24 And for the Big Island Homeowners Association?
- 25 MR. McELYEA: Your Honor, yes. My name is

- 1 Charles McElyea, Phillips, McElyea, Carpenter & Welch,
- 2 85 Court Circle, Camdenton, Missouri. Preliminarily also
- 3 I need to make a correction in the name. I filed a
- 4 special entry of appearance under the name of Big Island
- 5 Water & Sewer Association. It should be Big Island
- 6 Homeowners Water & Sewer Association, and I can file
- 7 amended pleadings to that effect if it please the Court.
- 8 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. Thank you. The
- 9 next names I'm going to list are the individual
- 10 complainants, and I believe they're all representing
- 11 themselves. So we'll begin with Cathy Orler. Is she
- 12 here?
- MS. ORLER: Yes. I'm behind the post here.
- 14 I'm Cathy Orler.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. And certainly you
- 16 can come on up to the table or come closer as you like.
- 17 Certainly during the informal portion of it I want
- 18 everybody up here to converse with each other as much as
- 19 possible.
- 20 Benjamin Pugh?
- 21 MR. PUGH: That is me, Judge. Been on Big
- 22 Island since 1962.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you. Ben Weir? I
- 24 believe you're on the phone, are you not, Mr. Weir?
- 25 MR. WEIR: That's correct, sir, I'm on the

- 2 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Stan Temares? I believe
- 3 he --
- 4 MS. ORLER: He's supposed to be calling.
- 5 MR. PUGH: I just talked to him about 15
- 6 minutes ago.
- 7 JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. Mr. Temares is
- 8 planning on calling in. He's not here yet. We'll go
- 9 ahead without him at this point. If he comes in later, he
- 10 can certainly join us.
- Judy Kenter?
- MS. KENTER: I'm here.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. Behind the pole
- 14 also.
- MS. KENTER: Yes.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Joseph Schrader?
- 17 MR. SCHRADER: Yes, I'm here. I'm the one
- 18 from De Land, Florida.
- 19 JUDGE WOODRUFF: And Mr. Schrader is also
- 20 on the phone.
- 21 Duane Stoyer?
- MR. STOYER: I'm here on the phone.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you. Cindy Fortney?
- MR. FORTNEY: I'm here.
- MS. FORTNEY: I'm here in person.

- 2 is here, and Dean Leon Fortney is on the telephone.
- For Staff?
- 4 MS. YOUNG: I'm Mary Weston, Assistant
- 5 General Counsel. My address is 200 Madison Street,
- 6 Jefferson City, Missouri.
- 7 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you. And for the
- 8 Office of Public Counsel?
- 9 MR. MILLS: Appearing on behalf of the
- 10 Office of Public Counsel, my name is Lewis Mills. My
- 11 address is Post Office Box 2230, Jefferson City, Missouri
- 12 65102. Thank you.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: And for the Department of
- 14 Natural Resources? Is anyone here for DNR?
- MR. MACEACHEN: John Maceachen, Public
- 16 Drinking Water.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Mr. Maceachen, are you an
- 18 attorney?
- MR. MACEACHEN: No, I'm not.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Yes, sir?
- 21 MR. SUMMERFORD: Breck Summerford with the
- 22 Public Drinking Water Program, permits chief for the
- 23 program.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: And I assume you're not an
- 25 attorney?

1 MR. SUMMERFORD: I'm an engineer.
```

- JUDGE WOODRUFF. Engineer.
- MS. SEON: Elena Seon, Department of
- 4 Natural Resources, Water Protection Program, compliance
- 5 and enforcement.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. And you're not an
- 7 attorney either?
- 8 MS. SEON: No.
- 9 JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. Well,
- 10 obviously we have a large group of people here today, and
- 11 for the benefit of the court reporter, particularly for
- 12 the people who are on the telephone, when you're going to
- 13 say something, if you want to say something, make sure you
- 14 tell her who you are so she doesn't have to try to
- 15 memorize either faces or voices for the people on the
- 16 telephone.
- 17 The main reason to bring you all here today
- 18 was to give you a chance to discuss this amongst
- 19 yourselves and to hopefully reach a resolution of all this
- 20 in entirety if you can. That's certainly not a
- 21 requirement. But also, even if you can't reach a total
- 22 settlement, you can reach hopefully some sort of an
- 23 agreement on how to proceed in this case and to give the
- 24 Commission some guidance on how to deal with these
- 25 complaints.

1 What I'm going to do is I'm going to ask
```

- 2 that counsel for Staff give me a report one week from
- 3 today as to what, if any, results occur today, if there's
- 4 been any sort of agreement amongst the parties as to how
- 5 to proceed. And if there is no agreement, you can just go
- 6 ahead and file a pleading to that effect. I would expect
- 7 that counsel for Staff will discuss this with everyone
- 8 else before she files that pleading.
- 9 MS. WESTON: Yes, I will, Judge.
- 10 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Thank you. There is one
- 11 pending motion out here that I probably need to deal with
- 12 at the start here, and that was a motion that was filed by
- 13 Cathy Orler on December 1st. It was a motion to compel
- 14 discovery of documents from Folsom Ridge. She requested
- 15 that Folsom Ridge be compelled to provide a membership
- 16 list for the Big Island Homeowners Association and as well
- 17 as a copy of that organization's bylaws.
- 18 Folsom Ridge responded on December 6, and
- 19 it contended that Big Island Homeowners Association is a
- 20 separate legal entity, and that Folsom Ridge does not
- 21 possess or control the requested documents. Before I make
- 22 a ruling on this, does anyone else have anything they want
- 23 to add?
- 24 (No response.)
- 25 JUDGE WOODRUFF: All right. I don't hear

1 anything, anyone stepping forward. I'll go ahead and rule

- 2 on the motion at this time, then.
- 3 Folsom Ridge claims a separate legal status
- 4 from the Big Island Homeowners Association, and the
- 5 claimants allege that they are in practice at least one
- 6 and the same entity. They allege that Folsom Ridge
- 7 controls Big Island Homeowners Association. That was the
- 8 allegation in the complaint.
- 9 Now, that's ultimately an issue that the
- 10 Commission may have to decide as part of this complaint as
- 11 to the extent that there is any control or if they are, in
- 12 fact, entirely separate organizations. However, the
- 13 Commission can't prejudge that issue. That's what the
- 14 complainants have to prove. Later on they may be able to
- 15 prove that they are, in fact, a single party, but there's
- 16 no proof of that now.
- 17 So for the moment the Commission must
- 18 recognize that these two entities are separate legal --
- 19 that they have a separate legal existence, and since they
- 20 are separate entities, Folsom Ridge cannot be ordered to
- 21 produce documents on behalf of the Big Island Homeowners
- 22 Association.
- 23 As an alternative, and I believe this was
- 24 mentioned in Folsom Ridge's response, that the
- 25 complainants can subpoena this information from the Big

- 1 Island Homeowners Association. So that's the alternative
- 2 available to them. They also might be able to obtain them
- 3 simply by asking Big Island Homeowners Association for
- 4 these documents. That's something that you can discuss
- 5 during your conference today. So at this time, then, the
- 6 motion to compel is denied.
- 7 Are there any other matters that anyone
- 8 wants to bring up while we're on the record?
- 9 MR. MILLS: Your Honor, just so that I'm
- 10 clear, is the Big Island Homeowners Association or
- 11 whatever the name that superseded that name, is that
- 12 entity a party to this case in the Commission's view?
- 13 JUDGE WOODRUFF: It has not been added as a
- 14 party. It was not named as a party and is not currently a
- 15 party. I believe that is one of the issues that can be
- 16 discussed today as to whether or not that entity should be
- 17 added as a party, and I appreciate them being here today.
- 18 Any other matters anyone wants to bring up
- 19 while we're on the record?
- 20 MR. WEIR: Judge, Ben Weir --
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Yes, Mr. Weir?
- 22 MR. WEIR: -- Blue Springs, Missouri.
- 23 Would someone -- Mr. McElyea please clarify that he is the
- 24 legal representative of the Big Island Homeowners
- 25 Association?

JUDGE WOODRUFF: Mr. McElyea, can you
```

- 2 address that?
- 3 MR. McELYEA: Yes. I've entered a special
- 4 entry of appearance on behalf of Big Island --
- 5 MR. WEIR: Then would he be --
- 6 MR. McELYEA: -- Homeowners Water & Sewer
- 7 Association.
- 8 MR. WEIR: -- the legal representative who
- 9 should be subpoenaed to produce the records that we are
- 10 wishing to have as far as the membership and the bylaws?
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Mr. McElyea?
- 12 MR. McELYEA: I'm sorry. I didn't hear his
- 13 question.
- 14 JUDGE WOODRUFF: His question was who would
- 15 be the legal representative of the Big Island Homeowners
- 16 Association to receive a subpoena?
- 17 MR. McELYEA: Well, it should be addressed
- 18 to the board and the officers of the association.
- 19 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay. And Mr. Weir, do
- 20 you know who that would be?
- 21 MR. WEIR: I believe that's three Folsom
- 22 Ridge representatives and two independent, allegedly
- 23 independent homeowners.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: Okay.
- 25 MR. COMLEY: We will sort that out later.

1 MR. WEIR: Rick Russo. I'm not for sure
```

- 2 who the third Folsom Ridge representative is. Now, I
- 3 believe Stan Zeldon and Dennis Boltz; is that correct?
- 4 MR. COMLEY: Your Honor, I think we can
- 5 sort out the appropriate custodian or other representative
- 6 to which a subpoena can be submitted when we get on to our
- 7 off the record portion here.
- 8 JUDGE WOODRUFF: Yeah. That was Mr. Comley
- 9 for Folsom Ridge, and he is correct that you'll have a
- 10 chance to do that informally. Right now we're having all
- 11 this transcribed, and we really don't need to have that
- 12 kind of discussion transcribed.
- 13 Anything else anyone wants to bring up
- 14 while we're still on the record? Then I'll give you a
- 15 chance to discuss this informally.
- 16 MR. COMLEY: Your Honor, I know that there
- 17 are other motions that Folsom Ridge has filed in
- 18 connection with this case, but we are not going to bring
- 19 them up on the strength of the Commission's representation
- 20 that those are stayed pending the conclusion of this
- 21 conference.
- JUDGE WOODRUFF: That's correct. With
- 23 that, then, the on-the-record portion of this conference
- 24 is adjourned.
