On May 22, 2015, the Staff of the Commission filed *Staff's Recommendation* on Ridge Creek Water Company, LLC's ("Ridge Creek") application for a certificate of convenience and necessity. The Commission issued an order setting a deadline for parties to file responses to *Staff's Recommendation* or to request an evidentiary hearing.

On June 2, Ridge Creek filed a motion requesting additional time to review Staff's filing and file a response. The Commission will grant Ridge Creek's motion and extend the deadline for parties to file responses to *Staff's Recommendation* or to request an evidentiary hearing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Responses to *Staff's Recommendation* may be filed no later than June 19, 2015.
2. Requests for an evidentiary hearing shall be filed no later than June 24, 2015.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
