On May 22, 2015, the Commission’s Staff filed a recommendation to approve TUK LLC’s application subject to several conditions. On June 2, 2015, the Office of the Public Counsel responded to the recommendation and requested an additional requirement that TUK LLC file a new rate case within 18 months of the effective date of an order setting rates after the proposed true-up audit. TUK LLC filed a response to the recommendation stating that it has no objection to the conditions in the Staff recommendation with one modification relating to tap fees and other miscellaneous fees. The Commission will provide an opportunity for any party to respond or object to the filings by the Office of the Public Counsel and TUK LLC.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any party wishing to respond or object to the filings by the Office of the Public Counsel and TUK LLC described above shall do so no later than June 11, 2015.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
