Sewer Extension Plan Review Fee:

A plan review Sewer of \$150.00 plus \$0.10 per lineal foot of sewer (8" diameter) and larger will be collected from the Applicant of the review of the proposed sewer extension by the Company. This fee will be paid at the time of the submittal of the plans to the Company.

Commercial and Industrial Building Plan Review Fee:

For the Class 1 Commercial Building, a building plan review fee of \$50.00 shall be collected, prior to the date of any such connection to the Company sanitary sewer system.

For Class 2 Commercial Building, a building plan review fee of \$50.00 plus \$10.00 per 1000 square feet shall be collected, prior to the date of any such connection to the Company sanitary sewer service system. The Maximum fee will be \$500.00.

For Class 1 Industrial Building, a building plan review fee of \$100.00 plus \$10.00 per 1000 square feet shall be collected, prior to the date of any such connection to the Company sanitary sewer system. The Maximum fee will be \$2000.00.

Pre-existing facilities which do not conform with these rules may remain, if said facilities do not cause any service problems and reconstruction is impractical.
- E. The company shall have the right to enter upon the customer's premises for the purpose of inspecting for compliance with these rules. Company personnel shall identify themselves and such inspections shall be conducted during reasonable hours.
