STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its recommendation states:

- 1. On February 28, 2011, Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints d/b/a Resthaven ("Rosewood") requested the Commission to recognize its name change to Rosewood Health and Rehab Center, L.L.C. Rosewood is a nursing home that is certificated with the Commission as a Shared Tenant Services provider.
- 2. Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060 establishes filing requirements for certificated company name changes; as noted in the attached Staff Memorandum, the Company has complied with the rule, including the customer notice provisions. No entities intervened to oppose the name change. The Company is not delinquent in any required filings with the Commission. STS providers are not required to file tariffs.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission issue an Order Recognizing the Name Change, acknowledging the name under which the Company does business as Rosewood Health and Rehab Center, L.L.C.
