**ORDER OPENING A WORKING CASE AND SCHEDULING A
WORKSHOP MEETING**

On June 25, 2018, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to open this case and to schedule a workshop meeting at which interested stakeholders can learn more about a proposed tariff filed by Missouri-American Water Company on June 15.¹ The revised tariff would update a mathematical formula for calculating taxes on contributions in aid of construction made to Missouri-American. Because this changed formula could have a significant impact on construction companies and property developers, Staff wants to seek comments from those stakeholders as it considers Missouri-American's tariff.² Further, Staff asks the Commission to direct Missouri-American to file an example of how its revised tariff is intended to work.

The Commission will grant Staff's motion. Importantly, Staff has only asked the Commission to open a working case regarding Missouri-American's tariff. The Commission

will not take any action regarding that tariff in this file. If Staff, or some other stakeholder, wants the Commission to suspend or reject that tariff, an appropriate motion to do so will need to be made in another file.

As this is not a contested case, anyone may file a comment without counsel and without *ex parte* constraints (arising from this matter).
