ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

Issue Date: March 20, 2015

Effective Date: April 12, 2015

On March 13, 2015¹, Missouri-American Water Company (“MAWC”) filed tariff sheets, effective April 12, to allow it to provide water service in Cole County, Missouri. MAWC filed the tariff as ordered by the Commission on March 11.

The Commission ordered its Staff to file a recommendation no later than April 2. Staff filed its Recommendation on March 19, stating that Staff recommended that the Commission approve the submitted tariff filing.

The Commission has authority to approve tariff sheets pursuant to Sections 393.140(11) and 393.150, RSMo. The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation. The Commission finds that the tariff sheets conform to the Commission's order granting MAWC the certificate of convenience and necessity. Thus, the Commission will approve the tariff sheets.
