## ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO RESPOND

On March 7, 2006 UCN, Inc. filed a proposed tariff designed to implement an Instate Connection Fee and an Instate Cost Recovery Charge bearing an effective date of April 7, 2006. The Office of the Public Counsel filed a Motion to Reject Tariff or, in the Alternative, to Suspend Tariff on March 28, 2006.

The Commission issued its Order Suspending Tariff and Setting Deadline to File Response to Motion to Reject Tariff on April 4, 2006. In that order the Commission suspended UCN's tariff for 30 days and required all responses to Public Counsel's motion be filed by April 7, 2006.

On April10, 2006, UCN filed Comments in Response to OPC Motion to Reject Tariff or, in the Alternative, to Suspend Tariff and a Motion to Accept Late-Filed Comments. UCN explained that the filing delay was due to an office problem that prevented the electronic filing of its comments.

Section (2) of 4 CSR 240-2.050 provides that the Commission may accept a filing out of time where the failure to timely file was the result of excusable neglect.

UCN's failure to timely file its response was due to excusable neglect, and its motion to accept late-filed comments will be granted.

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. UCN's Motion to Accept Late-Filed Comments is granted.
- 2. This order shall become effective on April 11, 2006.
