MOTION FOR EXPEDITED APPROVAL OF APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE SHARED TENANT SERVICES IN THE STATE OF MISSOURI

COMES NOW St. Anthony's Medical Center ("SAMC") pursuant to 4 CSR § 240-2.080(16) and, for its Motion for *Expedited Approval* of Application for Certificate of Service Authority to Provide Shared Tenant Services in the State of Missouri, states as follows:

1. SAMC filed its Application for Certificate of Service Authority to Provide Shared

Tenant Services in the State of Missouri on November 18, 2002 (the "Application"). On December 17, 2002, the Commission issued an Order Directing Filing noting that Staff of the Commission had not yet filed its recommendation regarding the Application and that "the Commission would like to move this case forward."

The Staff of the Commission issued a Staff Recommendation on December 18,
2002 recommending that SAMC's Application be approved.

3. SAMC respectfully requests that the Commission approve the Application on an expedited basis by January 5, 2003. As stated in its Application, SAMC desires to install, own, operate, control, manage and maintain shared tenant services for a location which consists of three adjoining medical professional buildings. The construction of these buildings has been recently completed and the physician-tenants for these buildings will begin occupying the premises beginning in January 2003, with the earliest move-in set to occur on January 6, 2003.

The physician-tenants will require telecommunication services immediately upon occupation of the premises.

4. By approving SAMC's Application by January 5, 2003, SAMC can provide the necessary telecommunication services for its physician-tenants as of their respective move-in date. By granting this Motion, there will be no negative effect on SAMC's customers; in fact, expedited approval of SAMC's Application will ensure that the physician-tenants have immediate access to reliable telecommunications service and, thus, properly serve their patients. SAMC's physician-tenant customers and the public interest will accordingly be benefited if the Commission acts by January 5, 2003.

5. This Motion was not filed earlier because SAMC expected that it would have the necessary approval prior to January 2003, the month during which many of the physician-tenants would be moving in to the new buildings. Due to the current status of its Application and because SAMC has been notified that physician-tenants will be moving in beginning January 6, 2003, expedited treatment is warranted.

WHEREFORE, St. Anthony's Medical Center respectfully requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission grant it a Certificate of Authority to install, own, operate, control, manage and maintain shared tenant services on an expedited basis by January 5, 2003.
