On June 25, 2020,¹ the Missouri Public Service Commission conducted an evidentiary hearing on the Complaint of Linda Beecham (Ms. Beecham) against Missouri-American Water Company (MAWC). At the conclusion of the hearing, the Commission ordered briefing and took the case under advisement. The Commission will reopen the record and order MAWC to file its records showing it either complied with or had a waiver from the requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-10.030(38) with respect to Ms. Beecham’s water meter.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The record in this case is reopened.
2. No later than September 26, 2020, MAWC shall file its records under proper affidavit showing it either complied with or had a waiver from the requirements of Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-10.030(38) at any time with respect to Ms. Beecham’s water meter.
