ORDER DIRECTING MISSOURI-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY TO FILE A STATUS REPORT

On December 13, 2007, the Commission granted Missouri-American Water Company a certificate of convenience and necessity to purchase and operate the Paradise Valley water system in Jefferson County, Missouri. As part of that order, the Commission directed Missouri-American to notify the Commission when it has completed the approved transaction and to submit new tariff sheets incorporating the newly approved service area into its St. Louis County water tariff.

Missouri-American has not yet submitted the anticipated tariff and the Commission would like to have an update from the company regarding the status of its purchase and operation of the water system.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Missouri-American Water Company shall file a status report regarding its purchase and operation of the Paradise Valley water system no later than March 25, 2008.

2. This order shall become effective on February 25, 2008.
