On October 29, 2014¹, pursuant to Section 393.170, RSMo 2000, and Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-2.060, 4 CSR 240-3.305, and 4 CSR 240-3.600, Missouri-American Water Company (hereafter "MAWC") filed an application with the Commission. MAWC requests that the Commission grant it authority to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain water system for the public in Cole County, Missouri.

The Commission ordered its Staff to respond no later than December 22. On December 19, Staff filed a Status Report. In that report, Staff stated that it needed another 30 days to complete its investigation. Further, Staff asked the Commission to order Staff to file a response no later than January 22, 2015.
