ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR LOCAL PUBLIC HEARING

On April 14, 2015, the Staff of the Commission requested a local public hearing in order to better understand customer service issues related to Ridge Creek Water Company, LLC's request for a certificate of convenience and necessity in an unincorporated area of Pulaski County, Missouri. The Commission will grant Staff's request and schedule a local public hearing. Consistent with statutory mandate, the Commission will set the date for a local public hearing to be held on April 29, 2015.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission gives notice that it will hold a local public hearing on April 29, 2015, beginning at 6:00 p.m. at the Waynesville City Hall, located at:

- 2. The Staff of the Commission shall hold a question-and-answer session before the Commission receives testimony.
- 3. The Commission will take on-the-record testimony from those wishing to make comments, beginning at the conclusion of the information session.
- 4. The local public hearing shall be held in a facility that meets the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. - 5. The Public Information Office of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall notify members of the Missouri General Assembly representing the residents in the requested service area in Pulaski County, Missouri and shall notify the news media serving the residents in the area.
- 6. The Data Center of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall notify the county commissioners of Pulaski County, Missouri.
