ORDER SETTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

The parties filed their *Joint Proposed Procedural Schedule* on July 7, 2015. The parties identified discovery conditions to which all parties agreed. The Commission will approve the proposed procedural schedule.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following procedural schedule is adopted:
 - A. Data request response times shall be 20 calendar days, with 10 calendar days to object or notify requesting party that additional time is needed to submit information.
 - B. After August 6, 2015, the deadline for data request responses shall be 5 business days to provide requested information, and 3 business days to object or notify requesting party that additional time is needed to submit information.
