## **ORDER GRANTING THE APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES**

On October 24, 2012, the Commission opened an investigation into the operations, management, and financial capabilities of Terre Du Lac Utilities Corporation. On October 31, the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) filed an application to intervene in that investigative case. More than ten days have passed since MDNR applied to intervene and no party has objected to that application.

As this is an investigative case, not a contested case, MDNR is able to participate in the case without formally intervening. However, a formal intervention provides the intervenor with easier access to documents within the Commission's electronic filing system. The Commission finds that allowing MDNR to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene. MDNR's intervention does not change the nature of this case and it remains a non-contested case.

### **THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Missouri Department of Natural Resources' Application to Intervene is granted.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
