Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri ("AT&T Missouri"), proposes to revise P.S.C. Mo.-No. 24, Local Exchange Tariff.

This tariff filing is being made in accordance with the Missouri Public Service Commission's Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement and Order Directing Filings issued on January 10, 2006 in Case No. TO-2005-0144. The attached tariff filing implements the Stipulation and Agreement.

Additionally, AT&T Missouri is filing tariff sheets that reflect the addition of Washington, Union, St. Clair, and Beaufort to the St. Louis MCA. 1.6 OPTIONAL METROPOLITAN CALLING AREA (MCA) SERVICE

1.6.1 Service Description

- A. Metropolitan Calling Area (MCA) service is available in three distinct areas in Missouri: the St. Louis MCA, the Kansas City MCA, and the Springfield MCA.
- (AT) B. The St. Louis, Kansas City, and Springfield Metropolitan Exchanges are included in the respective MCAs. The basic local calling scope for each of these exchanges is the MCA-wide calling scope set forth in 1.5.2, 1.5.3, and 1.5.4 of this tariff.
- C. In selected exchanges, MCA service is an optional service which provides the subscriber with an optional local calling area which includes the respective Metropolitan Exchange and certain customers in other exchanges where MCA service is also available, as described in Section 1.6.3 following.
- (CT) D. In each MCA, exchanges and Metropolitan Exchange Zones are grouped into different MCA rate classifications. In the St. Louis and Kansas City MCAs, exchanges where Optional MCA Service is available are classified as MCA-3, MCA-4 or MCA-5. In the Springfield MCA, (CT) exchanges where Optional MCA Service is available are classified as MCA-2.
