On March 6, 2006, Multiband, Inc., applied to the Commission for authority to provide private shared tenant services (STS). On May 30, the Commission ordered the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than June 28.

The Commission notes that Multiband has filed a motion for determination on the pleadings. Until the Commission rules on Multiband's motion, a proposed procedural schedule is premature. Therefore, the Commission will suspend the parties' requirement to file a proposed procedural schedule until further notice.

1. The Commission's May 30, 2006 order requiring the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule is suspended until further notice.
