APPLICATION

COMES NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL"), and, pursuant to 4 CSR 240-2.060 and 4 CSR 240-3.145, respectfully requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") issue an order approving: (1) a new Rate Schedule, "Special Contracts—Customer Specific"(attached hereto as Appendix 1) that allows KCPL and large customers to enter into Special Contracts subject to certain conditions contained in the tariff; and (2) the terms of a specific Special Contract contained in Appendix 2 HC between KCPL and one of its industrial customers. In support of its Application, KCPL states the following:

KCPL

1. KCPL is a Missouri corporation in good standing in all respects, with its principal office and place of business located at 1201 Walnut, Kansas City, Missouri 64106. KCPL is engaged in the generation, transmission, distribution, and sale of electric energy and power in those areas in Missouri certificated to it by the Commission, including the City of Kansas City, Missouri, as well as areas of eastern Kansas. KCPL is an "electrical corporation" and "public utility" as those terms are defined in Section 386.020 (15) and (42), RSMo 2000, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission as provided by law. KCPL's Certificate of Good Standing was filed in Case No. EO-2003-0527 and is incorporated herein by reference.

2. KCPL has no pending action or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it from any state or federal agency or court which involve customer service or rates which has occurred within three (3) years of the date of the Application.

3. No annual report or assessment fees are overdue.

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Approval Of The Rate Schedule

5. The purpose of the proposed rate schedule contained in Appendix 1 ("the Rate Schedule") is to allow KCPL and large customers to enter into Special Contracts subject to certain specified conditions. The Rate Schedule is available to Customers who entered into a Special

Contract with KCPL associated with the development of the "Experimental Regulatory Plan", which was approved by the Commission in Case No. EO-2005-0329. Under the terms of the Rate Schedule, the Special Contracts executed between KCPL and Customers must be approved by the Commission. KCPL will list the case number wherein such approval was obtained as a part of the tariff. This practice of identifying the case number, but not the name of the specific customer that is a party to the Contract, has been customarily used by KCPL and approved by the Commission with regard to other Special Contracts in past cases. The term of the Special Contracts will begin upon the approval of the Special Contracts by the Commission and continue until the termination date, as specified in the Customer's Special Contract.

Revenue Imputation Related To Special Contracts

6. In its Report and Order in *Re: In the Matter of a Proposed Regulatory Plan of Kansas City Power & Light Company*, Case No. EO-2005-0329, the Commission stated at page 17:

IMPUTATION OF REVENUES RELATED TO SPECIAL CONTRACTS

KCPL has agreed that for ratemaking determinations, customers using special contracts will be treated as if they were paying the full generally applicable tariff rate for service from KCPL, and other provisions in special contracts will not affect rate base for regulatory purposes.

7. Pursuant to the Stipulation And Agreement approved in the Report and Order in Case No. EO-2005-0329 and as a specific condition of the Rate Schedule, KCPL agrees that for ratemaking determinations, that Customers using Special Contracts under the proposed Rate Schedule, will be treated as if they were paying the full generally applicable tariff rate for service from KCPL, and other provisions in the Special Contract will not affect rate base for regulatory

purposes. As a result, no other customer class or individual customer will be adversely affected by the approval of such Special Contracts.

Approval Of The Special Contract

8. KCPL requests approval of the Special Contract contained in Appendix 2 HC. This Special Contract between KCPL and one of its large customers was entered into in connection with the development of the "Experimental Regulatory Plan" in Case No. EO-2005-0329. The identity of the Customer and specific terms of the Special Contract are designated as Highly Confidential and filed under seal. The Special Contract is intended to fulfill the specific requests and needs of the Customer with regard to the rates, terms and conditions of providing electric service to the Customer.

WHEREFORE, Kansas City Power & Light Company respectfully requests that Commission issue an order approving: (1) a new Rate Schedule, "Special Contracts—Customer Specific"(attached hereto as Appendix 1) that allows KCPL and large customers to enter into Special Contracts subject to certain conditions contained in the tariff; and (2) the terms of a specific Special Contract contained in Appendix 2 HC between KCPL and one of its industrial customers.
