## ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE

On June 19, 2008, Seges Partners Mobile Home Park, L.L.C. ("Seges"), filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission. It requests a certificate of convenience and necessity to operate a water system. Seges filed a similar application on May 11, 2009, asking for a certificate to operate a sewer system.

On May 22, 2009, Staff filed a Motion to Consolidate. Staff notes that the area Seges wishes to serve is the same for both cases. Staff thus asks the Commission to consolidate them. Also, Staff asks that the Commission allow it 30 days after the effective date of the order granting consolidation to file a combined recommendation

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows ten days to respond to pleadings. No party responded to Staff's motion; thus, the Commission will take it up unopposed.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.110(3) allows the Commission to consolidate pending actions involving related questions of law or fact. The two pending actions involving Seges involve related questions of law or fact. Therefore, the Commission will

grant Staff's motion. File No. WA-2008-0403 is designated as the lead case. All pleadings in the consolidated case shall bear File No. WA-2008-0403.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Motion to Consolidate is granted.
- 2. File No. SA-2009-0401 is consolidated with File No. WA-2008-0403. File No. WA-2008-0403 is designated as the lead case.
- 3. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation or a Status Report no later than July 25, 2009.
  - 4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
