INCLOSED ARE THE RECOMMENDATIONS THAT YOU HAVE REQUESTED, HOPEFULLY ITS ENOUGH TO ISSUE A CERTIFICATE OF CONVNIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE WATER SERVICE.

DESCRIPTION OF COMPANY, WOODLAND ACRES WATER SYSTEM. PLATS SHOWING WHERE EXISTING WATER LINES, WELLS AND EXISTING WATER CONNECTIONS ARE.

EXISTING FACILITIES, THERE ARE TWO (2) STATE APPROVED MULTI-FAMILY WELLS, AND APPROX. FIVEYTHOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FEET OF TWO (2) INCH WATER LINE. APPROX. COST TO INSTALL WAS \$18,000.00 DOLLARS. WATER SYSTEM IS COMPLEATED, AS OF JULY 2004.

TYPE OF EXISTING DWELLINGS, AT THE PRESENT TIME THERE ARE TEN (10) MOBILHOMES AND THREE (3) CONSTRUCTED.HOMES. FULL TIME LIVING POPULATION AT THIS TIME IS FIFTEEN (15) PEOPLE. ALSO AT THIS TIME THERE ARE FIVE PART TIME RESIDENTS THAT ARE USED FIVE (5) TO SIX (6) WEEKENDS PER YEAR, WHICH HAS TWO (2) PEOPLE PER RESIDENT, MAJORITY OF THE OWNERS WITHIN THE DEVELOPMENT ARE RETIRED, OUR OLD ENOUGH THAT THEIR KIDS ARE GROWN.

OVER THE NEXT THREE YEARS I EXPECT ONE OR TWO MORE RESIDENTS WITHIN THE SUBDIVISION, SEVERAL OWNERS DRILL THEIR OWN WELLS, SO DONT EXPECT THAT WE WILL EVER HAVE MORE THAN SEVENTEEN TO EIGHTEEN HOMES USING THIS WATER SYSTEM, OR MORE THAN THIRTY PEOPLE USEING THE WATER.

THERE IS NO WAY TO KNOW HOW MUCH WATER IS USED PER RESIDENT, WE HAVE NO METERS. BOTH WELLS ARE TIED TOGETHER, BETWEEN BOTH WELLS THEY PUMP FIFTY (50) GALLONS PER MINUTE, EACH WELL HAS A SIXTY GALLON BLADDER TANK, WE HAVE NEVER BEEN WITHOUT WATER PRESSURE. EACH RESIDENT HAS ITS OWN SEPTIC SYSTEM, THAT HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE ST CLAIR COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT. BOTH WELLS ARE 150 TO 200 FEET FROM ANY SEPTIC.

AS OF THIS DATE NO ONE HAS BEEN CHARGED A CONNECTION FEE. THE EXISTING YEARLY RATES FOR WATER USEAGE IS \$225.00 DOLLARS PER YEAR, PER CUSTOMER.

CURRENT GROSS INCOME FROM THE WATER SYSTEM, IS \$2,925.00 DOLLARS PER YEAR, AN AVERAGE OF \$18.75 PER MONTH. ALL LOTS HAVE BEEN SOLD, HAVE NO KNOWLEDGE OF ANYONE: PLANING TO PLACE A RESIDENT WITHIN THE DEVELOPMENT, SO ITS HARD TO ESTIMATE IF THERE WILL BE AN INCREASE IN THE WATER INCOME.SINCE SOME OWNERS DRILL OWN WELLS.


OPERATING EXPENSES, ITS HARD TO SAY WHAT EXPENSES WILL ACCRUE, SOME YEARS THERE WILL BE ONLY THE ELECTRIC EXPENSES TO RUN THE WELLS, WHICH WAS \$968.00 DOLLARS FOR 2007, BUT IN 2006 I HAD TO REPLACE A PUMP AND REPAIR TWO LINE BREAKS, WHICH COST \$19960 DOLLARS.

OPERATOR NAME: JERRY REED IS RESPONSIBLE FOR MAINTAINING THE WATER SYSTEM. AND SENDING WATER SAMPLES TO DNR EACH MONTH.

THERE IS NO CONTRACTS WITH THE WATER CUSTOMERS, AND NO METERS, WATER SERVICE TO WOODLAND ACRES CUSTONERS IS FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF THE CUSTOMERS, ITS NEVER BEEN FOR A PROFFIT BUSINESS. IF THERE IS ANYTHING ELSE YOU NEED PLEASE CALL.

This approval letter supersedes the previous approval letter of February 22, 1996 which required a public water supply.

The Woodland Acres Subdivision as described below has received an acceptable geological evaluation. The subdivision is approved according to Missouri Clean Water Commission Regulation 10 CSR 20-6.030, Disposal of Wastewater in Subdivisions.

#### PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Woodland Acres Subdivision - 40 lots, (23 lots greater than 3 acres) is a subdivision located on 115 acres in the E 1/2, SW 1/4, and NW 1/4, SE 1/4, Section 20, T39N, R24W, St. Clair County. Water supply for this development is provided by multifamily wells. Wastewater treatment and disposal is assumed to be individual septic tank & absorption field systems. However, please note that this approval does not guarantee that a suitable site for an on-site wastewater system is available on each lot.

Provided that the project remains as described in the project description, the project is hereby approved by the Department of Natural Resources. This approval is subject to the following conditions.

### APPROVAL CONDITIONS:

R & S Developing, Inc., successors and assigns hereinafter referred to as "developer" shall take all action necessary which may include but is not limited to filing restrictive covenants and enforcing these covenants against individual lot owners to ensure the following:

- a. Each individual sewage treatment system (hereinafter "system") shall be designed in accordance with this approval;
- b. No lot or tract shall be divided into smaller lots or tracts without prior approval of the Department of Natural Resources; and individual wells are not used if a public water supply is described in the Project Description.
- c. Residences are restricted to single family residences and only one shall be constructed on any lot or tract;
- d. It shall be the lot owner's responsibility to assure that the system receives proper operation and maintenance at all times;
- e. The effluent from the system shall be contained on the lot and handled in such a manner that there shall be no violation of the Missouri Clean Water Law and Regulations;

It is also the responsibility of the developer or his heirs, assigns, or successors to:

- Advise prospective lot purchasers of the terms and conditions of this approval, and furnish them a copy of this approval letter.
- 2. Advise lot purchasers that <u>all</u> on-site septic tank & absorption field disposal system designs must be approved by the County Health Department before construction begins.
- 3. Advise lot purchasers that soil profile evaluations must be conducted by a soil scientist, or qualified geologist or professional engineer on <u>all</u> proposed lateral field sites and submitted for review and approval to the County Health Department with the on-site wastewater system design.
- 4. Stormwater Control: Obtain a special Missouri State Operating Permit to discharge storm water for any land disturbance activities of five or more acres (10 CSR 20-6.200). This permit requires best management practices sufficient to control sediment runoff to protect waters of the state.
- 5. <u>Drinking Water Supplies</u>: Obtain approval from the Public Drinking Water Program (314/751-5331) in Jefferson City, Missouri for the construction of any <u>public</u> drinking water facilities.

#### SPECIAL CONDITIONS/INSTRUCTIONS

1. Care must be taken to prohibit traffic and use of heavy equipment on possible sites for lateral systems. Traffic will destroy the useful structure of the top horizons of soil. Any area compacted by traffic must not be used for lateral systems.

This letter of approval does not excuse the developer, the individual lot owners, or any other persons from any liability for violation of/or duties and responsibilities under the Missouri Clean Water Law and Regulations, or any other laws of the State of Missouri. If, at any time the installation or use of the wastewater disposal should result in a violation of the Missouri Clean Water Law or Regulations, or if any of the above conditions of approval are violated, this letter of approval may be revoked.

This approval may also be revoked if any changes are made in the development without first obtaining approval from the Department of Natural Resources. If you have any questions, please call Douglas Carmichael at this office.
