On August 26, 2011¹, pursuant to Section 393.170, RSMo 2000, and Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-2.060, 4 CSR 240-3.305, and 4 CSR-3.600, Missouri-American Water Company (hereafter "MAWC") filed two applications (as captioned in the style of these cases above) with the Missouri Public Service Commission. MAWC requests that the Commission grant it authority to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain water and sewer systems for the public in an incorporated village of Christian and Taney Counties, Missouri.

On February 12, 2012, Ag Processing, Inc., ("AGP") filed an intervention request. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to motions. No party objected to the application. Therefore, the Commission will take it up unopposed.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4) allows the Commission to grant intervention to a person who has an interest different from that of the general public and

which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or if granting intervention would serve the public interest. Upon review of the unopposed application, the Commission finds that AGP meets the standard in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4). Therefore, the Commission will grant the application to intervene.
