On October 29, 2014¹, pursuant to Section 393.170, RSMo 2000, and Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-2.060, 4 CSR 240-3.305, and 4 CSR-3.600, Missouri-American Water Company (hereafter “MAWC”) filed an application with the Commission. MAWC requests that the Commission grant it authority to install own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain water system for the public in Cole County, Missouri.

The Commission issued notice on October 30, giving potential intervenors until November 19 to request intervention. The Commission received no intervention requests.

The Commission will now order its Staff to respond.

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a status report or a recommendation no later than December 22, 2014.
