ORDER DIRECTING FILING

On October 29, 2014, pursuant to Section 393.170, RSMo 2000, and Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-2.060, 4 CSR 240-3.305, and 4 CSR 240-3.600, Missouri-American Water Company (hereafter “MAWC”) filed an application with the Commission. MAWC requests that the Commission grant it authority to install, own, acquire, construct, operate, control, manage, and maintain a water system for the public in Cole County, Missouri.

The Commission ordered its Staff to respond no later than January 22, 2015. On January 20, 2015, Staff filed a Status Report. In that report, Staff stated that it needed another 30 days to complete its investigation. Further, Staff asked the Commission to order Staff to file a response no later than February 23, 2015.

The Commission finds Staff’s request reasonable, and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Commission shall file a status report or a recommendation no later than February 23, 2015.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
