**ORDER SUSPENDING TARIFF AND SETTING DEADLINE TO FILE  
RESPONSE TO MOTION TO REJECT TARIFF**

Issue Date: April 4, 2006

Effective Date: April 7, 2006

**Syllabus:** This order suspends UCN, Inc.'s tariff for 30 days and sets Monday, April 10, 2006, as the deadline to respond to the Office of the Public Counsel's Motion to Reject Tariff or, in the Alternative, to Suspend Tariff.

On March 7, 2006, UCN Telecom, Inc., filed a proposed tariff designed to implement an Instate Connection Fee and an Instate Cost Recovery Charge. The tariff bears an effective date of April 7, 2006.

On March 28, 2006, the Office of the Public Counsel filed a Motion to Reject Tariff or, in the Alternative, to Suspend Tariff. In its motion, the Public Counsel moves the Commission to reject the tariff, or in the alternative, suspend the tariffs and hold an evidentiary hearing.

In order to allow the parties the opportunity to respond to Public Counsel's motion and allow the Commission to further investigate the proposed tariff to determine whether it is lawful and reasonable, the Commission will suspend it.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The Public Counsel's Motion to Suspend Tariff is granted.
2. The following tariff sheets filed by UCN, Inc., and assigned Tariff File No. JX-2006-0675, are suspended until May 7, 2006, or until otherwise ordered by the Commission:

3. All responses to Public Counsel's motion must be filed on or before Friday, April 7, 2006.
4. This order shall become effective on April 7, 2006.
