On March 6, 2006, MultiBand, Inc., applied to the Commission for authority to provide private shared tenant services (STS). Southwestern Bell Telephone, L.P., d/b/a AT&T Missouri, intervened. The Commission ordered the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than May 29.

On May 24, MultiBand, the Staff of the Commission and AT&T Missouri filed a Joint Motion for Extension of Time for Filing Procedural Schedule. They alleged that additional time would be useful before a procedural schedule needs to be filed, and ask for an extension until June 28. Further, the movants state that the Office of the Public Counsel does not object to the motion.
