## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE

On October 30, 2009, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting FreedomStarr Communications, Inc.'s ("FreedomStarr") certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications service in the State of Missouri be canceled. The Commission granted FreedomStarr a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications service in the State of Missouri on January 20, 1999,<sup>1</sup> in File No. TA-99-244.

The Commission need not hold a hearing if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed ten days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
