APPLICATION

COMES NOW TON Services Inc. ("TON" or "Applicant") and requests a Certificate of Service Authority to provide competitive intrastate interexchange telecommunications services between and among locations within the state of Missouri pursuant to Section 392.440, RSMo (1994), an order classifying Applicant as a competitive telecommunications carrier, an order waiving or suspending certain Commission rules and statutory provisions pursuant to Section 392.440, and an order waiving or suspending certain Commission rules and statutory provisions pursuant to Section 392.420. In support of its request, Applicant provides the following information:

1. Applicant is a corporation organized under the laws of Utah. Its principal office is located at:

TON is a Utah corporation. The Company was incorporated on June 15, 1992. Copies of Applicant's Articles of Incorporation and Certificate of Authority to transact business in Missouri are attached hereto as Exhibit I and incorporated herein by reference.

2. TON Services Inc. seeks authority to provide prepaid card intrastate long distance service in conjunction with its interstate service offerings to residential and business customers.

Ţ,

Customers establish an account with the Company by purchasing an account code and the associated initial balance of available usage on the Company's network. Customers can use the service by dialing the Company's toll free number, followed by the account code which the customer purchased. The Company's computer equipment informs the customer of the amount of available balance remaining each time the customer uses the particular account. Customers can enter any destination telephone number and use the service until such available balance is fully depleted.

Depletion occurs on a real time basis as each call takes place. The Company's computer equipment times the duration of each connected call and deducts from the available balance the tariffed rate per minute for each minute connected. The available balance is maintained until the customer's usage depletes the balance to zero. The computer equipment notifies the customer when five units and two units of usage remain on the card while a call is in progress. With certain cards, customers may renew the balance with a charge to a commercial credit card if such charge is approved by the credit card institution, or at Flying J travel plazas.

Unlike traditional business and residential long distance, TON 's prepaid service is not associated with any customer-provided access line, telephone number, or physical billing address. The prepaid nature of the service also eliminates the need for customers to sign letters of agency or to receive and subsequently remit payment in arrears. Therefore, there is no concern regarding "slamming."

- 4. TON intends to provide prepaid card intrastate long distance service on a twenty-four (24) hour a day basis, originating and terminating throughout the state of Missouri.
- 5. TON possesses managerial and technical expertise to provide resale interexchange telecommunications services.
- 6. TON possesses sufficient financial resources to provide the services proposed in this application.
- 7. TON's tariff containing the rules and regulations applicable to its customers, a description of the services offered, and a list of rates associated with such services is being filed simultaneously with this application showing a forty-five (45) day effective date.
- 8. TON requests classification as a competitive telecommunications company operating within the state of Missouri. TON further requests classification of services described in its tariff as competitive services.
- 9. TON, pursuant to Section 386.570, will comply with all applicable Commission rules except those which are specifically waived by the Commission pursuant to a request filed by TON.

- 10. Applicant will not unjustly discriminate among its customers, which discrimination is prohibited pursuant to Section 392.200.

WHEREFORE, TON Services Inc. respectfully requests the Commission to grant it a certificate of service authority to offer competitive intrastate interexchange telecommunications service within the state of Missouri; an order classifying it as a competitive telecommunications company providing competitive service; an order suspending, waiving or modifying the above referenced rules and statutory provisions as they relate to the regulation of the Applicant in the state of Missouri, and for such further orders as the Commission deems appropriate.


