ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO APPEAR

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the motion for leave to appear (“motion”) filed by Public Wireless, Inc.’s (Public Wireless) external general counsel (“counsel”). Counsel filed the motion on August 21, 2009, and filed an addendum to the motion on August 25, 2009. The motion complies with the requirements of the controlling rules¹ and regulations² because it:

- Designates two members of the Missouri Bar as associate counsel,³
- Is accompanied by entries of appearance by each associate counsel,⁴
- Includes a receipt for the fee required under Rule 6.01(m).⁵
- Identifies the courts in which counsel is admitted to practice,⁶ and
- Certifies that neither counsel nor any member of counsel’s firm is barred from appearing in such court.⁷

Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.
