

JOINT PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Applicants, and the Office of Public Counsel, and for its joint proposed procedural schedule, states as follows:

1. On June 21, 2005, the Commission issued its Order Consolidating Cases involving the applications of the subsidiary companies of eight rural electric cooperatives. On June 22, 2005, the Commission issued its Order Directing the Parties to File a Proposed Procedural Schedule ordering the parties to consult with each other and jointly file a proposed procedural schedule not later than June 30, 2005.


2. The parties propose the following procedural schedule:

- * July 14, 2005: Applicants' Response to Staff's Recommendation
- * July 25, 2005: Staff's Reply
- * August 9, 2005: Pre-hearing Conference for discussing settlement or, in the alternative, developing a procedural schedule for setting dates for testimony or stipulation of facts, if appropriate, and hearing.


WHEREFORE, the parties recommend that the Commission adopt its Joint Proposed
