ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND

On February 27, 2015, Missouri-American Water Company filed a petition asking the Commission to promulgate a new regulation to establish procedures for creation of a revenue decoupling mechanism for the water and sewer industry. Staff filed a recommendation on April 1, advising the Commission to not proceed with the rulemaking requested by Missouri-American. On the same date, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) also responded on that date. MIEC opposes Missouri-American's petition.

The Commission will establish a date for the filing of responses to those recommendations.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any person or entity wishing to respond to the recommendations offered by Staff and the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers shall file a written response no later than April 7, 2015.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
