**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING TIME FOR FILING**

The Missouri Public Service Commission is setting the date for filing an application to intervene, directing Staff to file a recommendation, and directing notice in accordance with the *Supplement to Application*.<sup>1</sup> In that filing the applicants stated that no portion of any political subdivision, in which any relevant asset<sup>2</sup> is located, extends beyond Moniteau County. Therefore, the Commission will direct that information on tax revenue impact be sent accordingly.<sup>3</sup>

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall send the application to the county clerk of Moniteau County.
2. Any application to intervene shall be filed no later than August 20, 2015.
3. No later than September 4, 2015, the Commission’s staff shall file its recommendation on the application, and send copies to the county clerk of Moniteau County.
