#### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

- On May 13, 2009, Sprint Communications Company L.P., Sprint Spectrum L.P., Nextel
  West Corporation, and Southwestern Bell Telephone Company, d/b/a AT&T Missouri,
  collectively known as the parties, filed with the Commission interconnection agreements
  reached through arbitration.
- 2. On May 14, 2009, the Commission issued an *Order Directing Filing*, directing Staff to file a recommendation on or before May 26, 2009.
- 3. 4 CSR 240-36.050 provides the procedure for the Commission's approval of interconnection agreements reached by arbitration. Staff is to review an agreement and determine whether it complies with the requirements of sections 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the Act), Missouri statutes, and the Commission's rules.
- 4. Staff has reviewed the proposed agreements and finds they are consistent with Sections 251 and 252 of the Act. It does not discriminate against any other carrier, is not against the public interest, and appears to conform to the Arbitrator's April 13, 2009 Final Report. The *Staff Recommendation* is attached and labeled as Attachment A.

5. Staff states the parties are current in the reporting and assessment requirements of the Commission.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends the Missouri Public Service Commission approve the arbitrated interconnection agreements filed with the Commission on May 13, 2009, at its earliest convenience.
