ORDER CANCELING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY
AND ACCOMPANYING TARIFFS

On March 24, 2005, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion to cancel the certificate of service authority granted to IP Communications Corporation d/b/a IP Communications of the Southwest Corporation. The company was granted a certificate to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in January of 2000, in Case No. TA-2000-390.

Staff informs the Commission that the Missouri Secretary of State reports that the company's certificate to do business in Missouri was revoked on February 19, 2004, because the company failed to file its Annual Registration Report. Furthermore, Staff states that mail sent to the company has been returned as undeliverable for the past two years and the company's telephone number is incorrect. Staff informs the Commission that the company does not owe the Commission any assessments, but has not submitted an annual report in recent years.

Staff seeks cancellation of the company's certificate because the company has failed to keep the Commission informed of its current address and telephone number.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) states that parties shall not be allowed more than ten days in which to file a responsive pleading. More than ten days have expired since Staff filed its motion, yet the company has not responded.

Section 392.410(5), RSMo 2000, states: "Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected. . . ." The Commission has reviewed Staff's motion and finds that granting the motion is reasonable. The Commission will cancel the certificate of service authority granted to IP Communications in Case No. TA-2000-390. The Commission will also cancel the company's tariffs.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission's motion to cancel the certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff of IP Communications Corporation d/b/a IP Communications of the Southwest Corporation is granted.
2. That the certificate of service authority granted to IP Communications Corporation d/b/a IP Communications of the Southwest Corporation in Case No. TA-2000-390, is canceled.
3. That the accompanying tariffs, PSC MO Tariff No. 1 and PSC MO Tariff No. 2 are canceled.
4. That this order shall become effective on April 21, 2005.

5. That this case may be closed on April 22, 2005.
