STAFF MOTION FOR CANCELLATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its Motion, states as follows:

1. On March 31, 2005, ATX Licensing, Inc. ("the Company") was granted authority to provide interexchange telecommunications services in File No. XA-2005-0272. Its tariff, YX-2005-0614, remains in effect.

2. On November 23, 2010, the Company filed an application as captioned above that was not signed by a Missouri attorney. However, the Staff may move that that the Company's certificate and tariff be cancelled by construing the application to be a statement that it had ceased operations in Missouri and requesting that its certificate be cancelled and its tariff withdrawn.

3. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo 2000, which provides "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the Certificate of Service Authority and tariff for ATX Licensing, Inc.
