ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On July 8, 2015, the Commission issued an order setting a procedural schedule in this matter. On August 6, the Staff of the Commission filed *Staff's Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule and Motion for Expedited Treatment*. Staff states that an agreement has been reached between Staff and Ridge Creek Water Company, LLC. Staff indicates that once the agreement is incorporated into a written agreement, it will be filed with the Commission and circulated to all parties.

Staff also requests the Commission issue an order in an expeditious manner since today is the deadline for parties to file direct testimony. Staff states that it has either conferred or attempted to confer with counsel for all other parties, and that counsel for Ridge Creek Water Company, LLC does not object to the expeditious granting of this motion. The Commission finds good cause exists to grant Staff's motion to suspend the procedural schedule.
