Concurring Opinion of Commissioner Davis

I join in the majority in approving the tariffs at issue because I believe the charge is lawful. However, I do not believe the majority opinion adequately expresses my concern about the appearance of the surcharge on customers' bills. The use of surcharges can confuse customers about the true per-minute rate they are paying, and cause difficulty in comparing the service offerings of competing companies. My additional concern is that bills may be formatted and presented in such a way as to lead customers to believe this surcharge is akin to a tax or fee imposed by government regulation. The surcharge is simply one way of creating a rate structure that enables MCI WorldCom to generate revenue, and MCI WorldCom should ensure that it is presented as such to its customers.
