On February 28, 2011, the Reorganized Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints d/b/a Resthaven requested the Commission to recognize its name change to Rosewood Health and Rehab Center, L.L.C. Rosewood is a nursing home that is certificated with the Commission as a Shared Tenant Services (STS") provider. No entity intervened or opposed the name change.

On March 24, 2011, Staff filed its recommendation. Staff states that Rosewood is in compliance with the requirements of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060 to have its name change recognized. STS providers are not required to file tariffs, so no tariff is required to effectuate the name change. Staff further states that the company is not delinquent in filing an annual report, paying the PSC assessment, MoUSF, and Relay Missouri. Consequently, the Commission will recognize the requested name change.
