NOTICE OF DISMISSAL

On November 23, 2011, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion for the cancellation of the certificates of service authority and associated tariffs held by Velocity The Greatest Phone Company Ever, Inc. ("Company"). The Commission issued an order on November 29, 2011, directing any party to file responses to the Staff's motion for cancellation no later than December 9, 2011.

Over the course of several months, Staff filed periodic status reports indicating that the Company has received corporate reinstatement with the Missouri Secretary of State and has corrected deficiencies in its calendar year 2009 and 2010 annual report filings. On July 2, 2012, Staff withdrew its pending motions to cancel the Company's certificates of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange service and basic local exchange service.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) states that an applicant or complainant may dismiss a complaint without an order of the Commission before prepared testimony or oral evidence has been offered. The parties have not offered prepared testimony or oral evidence. The Commission, therefore, will take notice of Staff's dismissal. This case shall be closed.
