## PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff), and for its proposed procedural schedule, states as follows:

1. On August 9, 2005, the Commission held a prehearing conference and the presiding officer ordered the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule by August 16, 2005.

2. The Staff and counsel for Applicants discussed a plan that could lead to the development of a stipulation of facts. This plan includes the use of conference calls, meetings, on-site inspections and discussions. Staff would also be afforded the possibility, if needed, of meeting company representatives of all eight applicants at the location of one of two pre-scheduled monthly board meetings that are routinely held by the applicants on the fourth Thursday of every month. The parties believe that sufficient time is needed to investigate and to develop a possible stipulation of facts. Therefore, the parties propose to file either a stipulation of facts or a procedural schedule not later than October 11, 2005.

3. The Staff has reviewed this proposed procedural schedule with counsel for Applicants and files this on behalf of the parties to this case.

WHEREFORE, the Staff submits this proposed procedural schedule on behalf of the parties and in accordance with the Commission order from the August 9, 2005 prehearing conference.
