On January 14, 2010, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting the Commission to cancel TransWorld Network, Corp.'s certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications service in the state of Missouri. On December 27, 1999, in File No. TO-2000-352, the Commission recognized the name change of London Telecom Network, Corp., a certificated interexchange service provider in Missouri, to TransWorld Network, Corp. and approved TransWorld's tariff.

The Commission need not hold a hearing if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.<sup>1</sup> Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed ten days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
