On September 29, 2015, BellSouth Long Distance, Inc., d/b/a AT&T Long Distance Service ("AT&T Long Distance Service") filed a motion requesting the Commission cancel their certificates of service authority.

In Case Number TA-97-476, the Commission granted AT&T Long Distance Service a certificate to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services.

The Commission will direct its Staff to review the request and file a recommendation regarding the cancellation of AT&T Long Distance Service's certificate of service authority.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. No later than October 13, 2015, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file with the Commission a recommendation regarding the BellSouth Long Distance, Inc., d/b/a AT&T Long Distance Service request to cancel its certificate of service authority.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
