#### ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION

On September 27, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed a motion recommending that the Commission cancel the certificate of interexchange telecommunications service authority and Tariff No. YX-2003-1847 of X2Comm, Inc., d/b/a DC Communications (Company). The Commission previously granted a certificate to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications service authority to the Company in Case No. XA-2003-0451 on June 5, 2003.

In its motion, Staff states that the Company filed a letter with the Commission on July 7 asking the Commission to cancel the Company's certificate and tariff, and that the Company has transferred all of its customer base to Legent Comm LLC d/b/a Long Distance America, and no longer offers telecommunications services in Missouri.

The Commission need not hold a hearing if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.<sup>1</sup> Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.
