## ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE

On August 17, 2009, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting Pacific Centrex Services, Inc.'s ("Pacific") certificate of service authority to provide interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunication service, restricted to providing dedicated private line services, and competitive basic local telecommunications services in the State of Missouri be cancelled. The Commission granted Pacific a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunication service in the State of Missouri in File Number XA-2004-0509. The Commission granted Pacific a certificate of service authority to provide competitive basic local telecommunications services in the State of Missouri in File Number CA-2004-0508.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.<sup>1</sup> Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff's motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificate based on Staff's motion.
