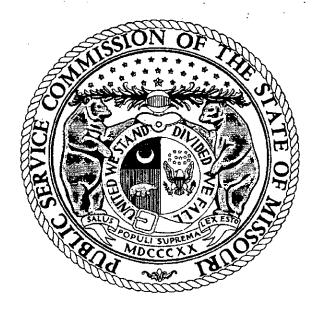

STAFF'S FINDINGS CONCERNING PROVISION OF SERVICE TO EAGLE WOODS SUBDIVISION



January 2006

Staff's Findings Concerning Provision of Service to Eagle Woods Subdivision

The Auditing Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (the Staff) was directed to review the books and records of Environmental Utilities, LLC (EU) and Osage Water Company, Inc. (OWC), as a result of actions taken by EU to serve OWC and its customers a disconnection notice for the non-payment of wholesale water bills by OWC.

EU is a regulated water company and holds a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to serve unincorporated portions of Camden County, Missouri. The owners of EU are Mr. Gregory D. Williams and Ms. Debra Williams, and they operate that utility. OWC is a regulated sewer and water company and holds a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to serve various utility systems in the Camden County, Missouri area. Mr. Williams also owns 50% of the voting stock for OWC. Therefore, EU and OWC are affiliated companies as defined in CSR-240-20.015. The other primary owner of OWC is Mr. William P. Mitchell, who is OWC's registered agent, president and director. Eagle Woods Subdivision (Eagle Woods) is within the certificated area of OWC, and OWC is responsible for the provision of sewer and water service to Eagle Woods. However, OWC does not own the plant in service (i.e., water well) necessary to provide water service to Eagle Woods. OWC is only able to provide water service to Eagle Woods by purchasing water from EU through a wholesale water contract between EU and OWC, and in turn providing that water to Eagle Woods.

Prior to September 30, 2005, EU operated OWC under the provisions of an operation and maintenance agreement (O&M Agreement) that was dated September 1, 2002. Under this O&M Agreement, EU was ". . . expressly authorized to collect all revenues due and owing to Osage Water Company . . . and to pay therefrom all expenses incurred in the operation of the

water and sewer utility systems now owned by Osage Water Company, and to reimburse therefrom the expenses incurred by Environmental Utilities, LLC for payroll, including any taxes thereon, for personnel employed by Environmental Utilities, LLC, equipment rental, transportation expenses, sales taxes, insurance premiums or any other expenses arising from or relating to the operation of said water and sewer utility systems . . ." Therefore, as a practical matter, this contract gave EU full financial and operational control of OWC. Additionally, under the terms of the agreement OWC expressly appointed EU ". . . as its agent for the purpose of operating, maintaining, and repairing the water and sewer utility systems owned by OWC . . ."

Beginning in May 2005, OWC operating revenues from the Cedar Glen development (a group of customers served by OWC) were garnished through a Camden County Court Order. The Staff's understanding is that the garnishment was granted on the basis of a long running dispute between Cedar Glen and OWC for the alleged lack of payment by OWC for construction and development of the Cedar Glenn water and sewer system. The Staff is also aware that OWC or its representatives did not appear before the court and lost the garnishment case by default. The effect of the garnishment significantly reduced the monthly revenues received by OWC for utility service. EU provided documents to the Staff valuing lost revenues associated with the garnishment at \$36,138 for the period of May 4, 2005 to September 30, 2005.

On December 31, 2002, the Missouri Public Service Commission brought suit against OWC in Camden County Circuit Court case number CV-102-965CC, seeking the appointment of a receiver for OWC. The Commission alleged that OWC had been effectively abandoned by its owners and that OWC was unable or unwilling to provide safe and adequate utility service

to its customers. On October 21, 2005 the Circuit Court of Camden County placed OWC's operations in receivership. Mr. Gary V. Cover was appointed by the court as receiver and is currently responsible for the day-to-day operations of OWC. Beginning in July 2005 OWC ceased paying its bills to EU related to the provision of water service to Eagle Woods. EU delivered a disconnection notice to Eagle Woods customers, dated December 12, 2005, with an effective shutoff date of December 27, 2005. The disconnection notice stated that the amount due to EU for the provision of water service to Eagle Woods was \$5,009.67. Mr. Cover has attempted to satisfy EU's demand for payment by remitting to EU \$1,096.50 on December 12, 2005, which represents payment for the billed water usage of Eagle Woods since October 21, 2005. Mr. Cover is disputing the alleged remaining unpaid balance for the period prior to his being appointed receiver, as specifically provided for in EU's tariff. In response to these actions by Mr. Cover, EU has extended the threatened disconnection date by thirty days to January 26, 2006.

The Staff was directed to perform this audit of the books and records of EU and OWC by Mr. Robert Schallenberg, the Commission's Utility Services Division Director, on December 29, 2006. The intent of this audit was to examine the books and records of EU and OWC, to determine if OWC had the financial ability to pay for Eagle Woods' water supply, and to determine whether EU had good cause to serve a disconnection notice to OWC as a result of OWC's non-payment of costs to supply Eagle Woods with water. The Staff submitted an initial document request to EU on December 29, 2005 to obtain the documents that were needed to perform this audit. On December 30, 2005, the Staff arrived at EU's office in Sunrise Beach, Missouri, reviewed the documents with Ms. Williams, and brought them back to our office in Jefferson City, Missouri. After reviewing these records, the Staff requested

additional information from Mr. Williams of OWC and EU through Mr. Keith Krueger of the Commission's General Counsels Office, on January 10, 2006.

In this audit, the Staff received EU and OWC data only through September 30, 2005 based on the fact that the Camden County Circuit Court placed OWC's operations in receivership on October 21, 2005. In conjunction with this receivership, EU terminated the OWC operating contract with Mr. Pat Mitchell effective September 30, 2005.

The Staff's review of facts concerning this audit produced the following findings:

1. Based upon the evidence reviewed to date by the Staff through its audit of OWC and EU's books and records, the Staff has determined that sufficient funds from OWC should have been available for OWC to pay its necessary expenses to EU related to the provision of water service to Eagle Woods through September 2005. The Staff finds that EU, acting as the direct agent for OWC through the O&M Agreement, has an utmost fiduciary responsibility to the utility customers of OWC to provide safe and adequate service. The Staff's financial analysis of OWC shows that OWC continued to pay certain discretionary expenses (such as salary amounts to Ms. Williams and payment of legal fees and other various costs to Mr. Williams) that would have been sufficient to make continued payments under the wholesale water contract for Eagle Woods. The parties making the decisions on OWC's behalf to continue making these discretionary payments are the same individuals that made the decision on behalf of EU to serve a disconnection notice on OWC. The Staff contends it is disingenuous of EU to serve OWC with a disconnection notice for nonpayment when the responsibility for payment of all OWC bills clearly rested with the principals of EU. The Staff recognizes the fact that the garnishment of Cedar Glenn revenues had a significant

- impact on the cash flow of OWC and its agent EU. However, as the Staff's analysis (Exhibit 1) illustrates, EU had the ability even after the garnishment occurred to pay the water bills associated with the provision of water service to Eagle Woods.
- 2. Additionally, the Staff has recommended in previous cases that OWC should meter the water usage of all of its customers. If this recommendation had been carried out by OWC, that company would had had a more accurate accounting of water used by its Eagle Woods customers, and also would have increased revenues for OWC from its service to Eagle Woods to offset the cost of purchased water from EU. However, only eight of the twenty-four customers of Eagle woods currently have meters installed. For the five months ending September 30, 2005, EU's master meter log indicates that the Eagle Woods customers used 1,416,200 gallons of water. But the eight Eagle Woods customers that are metered only used 216,357 gallons. By the Staff's calculation OWC lost approximately \$2,882 in revenues due to system leaks and not metering all of its customers during this period.
- 3. Nothing in this report is intended as an attempt to determine if OWC's rates set by the Missouri Public Service Commission for Eagle Woods were sufficient or insufficient. To determine adequacy of rate levels, the Staff would need to perform a cost-of-service analysis of all of the operating systems of OWC, not just Eagle Woods. It would be inappropriate to attempt to determine the adequacy or inadequacy of overall customer rates based on review of just one individual system within a utility.
- 4. The results and conclusions contained in this report are based upon a review of OWC's and EU's general ledger, check register and billing records. As previously stated, the Staff's analysis of these documents required the Staff to request additional documents

from OWC and EU. These requested documents include actual bank statements for OWC and EU, reconciliation by OWC of the alleged delinquent water bills in question as of September 30, 2005 and an explanation of expense recorded in OWC's general ledger for Mr. Gregory D. Williams. The findings in this report may be subject to change if, and when, this additional information is made available to the Staff.
