ORDER DENYING MOTION REQUESTING FORMAL ENTRY OF
APPEARANCE

On February 15, 2007, Ms. Orler, one of the intervenors in this matter, filed a motion requesting that attorney Pamela Holstead be required to file a formal entry of appearance in relation to Attorney Holstead's February 13, filing of the supplemental direct testimony of Gail Snyder. Ms. Orler correctly recites Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080's requirement that all pleadings require a signature, and correctly notes that Attorney Holstead's cover letter only bears a typed signature line, a method of signature that is allowed with electronic filing. However, Ms. Orler is incorrect that this cover letter, which is classified as correspondence, is a "pleading" requiring a signature. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.010(13) excludes correspondence from the definition of pleadings.


There is also no requirement for Attorney Holstead to define the extent of her representation for Big Island Water Company and Big Island Sewer Company, which is a matter of contract between Attorney Holstead and those companies. Attorney Holstead

shall make all required entries of appearance for proceedings before this Commission at the times in which they are required, and if she fails to do so, the Commission will enforce its requirements *sua sponte*. Ms. Orlor's motion shall be denied

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Cathy J. Orlor's "Motion to the Commission to Request Ms. Pamela Holstead to File a Formal Entry of Appearance for Clarification, or Other Form of Relief as May Be Deemed Necessary by the Commission" is hereby denied.
2. This order shall become effective on February 16, 2007.
