ORDER APPROVING COMPLIANCE TARIFF

Issue Date: March 17, 2011

Effective Date: March 21, 2011

On December 22, 2010, Missouri-American Water Company filed a petition to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (ISRS) rate schedule to recover ISRS-eligible costs. In accord with a recommendation filed by its Staff, to which Missouri-American acceded, the Commission approved Missouri-American's request to adjust its ISRS, but allowed the company to recover a smaller amount through that ISRS. In the same order, the Commission rejected the tariff Missouri-American had submitted along with its application because that tariff did not correctly describe the reduced amount the company would be allowed to recover through the ISRS.

Having rejected the company's initial tariff, the Commission gave Missouri-American leave to file a new tariff to recover the amount of revenue authorized in that order. Missouri-American filed its revised tariff on March 11. That tariff carries an April 10 effective date, but Missouri-American asks the Commission to approve the tariff on an expedited basis so the ISRS can go into effect on March 21.

On March 17, Staff filed a recommendation indicating Missouri-American's tariff complies with the Commission's order that approved the company's ISRS. Staff advises the Commission to approve the tariff and indicates it does not oppose the effective date proposed by Missouri-American in its motion for expedited treatment.

Based on Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the tariff submitted by Missouri-American complies with the Commission's order approving the companies ISRS. The Commission further finds that Missouri-American has established good cause to approve its compliance tariff on an expedited basis because expedited approval of the tariff will afford Missouri-American the timely rate relief that the Commission found to be justified.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion for Expedited Treatment filed by Missouri-American Water Company on March 11, 2011, is granted.
2. The tariff sheet issued on March 11, 2011, by Missouri-American Water Company, is approved to become effective on March 21, 2011. The tariff sheet approved is:

3. This order shall become effective on March 21, 2011.
4. This case shall be closed on March 22, 2011.
